MONEY SAVING TIPS:

Food is an essential part of the family budget, but try using some simple tips to help reduce your grocery bill:

Never shop when you're hungry, thirsty or tired... you tend to buy extra items when you're hungry whether you realise it or not.

Only buy what you need... always shop with a list. Products always go on sale again... don't feel like you'll miss out!

Buy in bulk... Buy meat in bulk and save. Certain items like toilet paper, laundry liquid and non-perishables cost much less when buying in bulk.

Compare Unit Prices Many shops are displaying the unit price of each product per 100 grams or per roll etc. This makes it much easier to compare products/brands and see what is the best value for your dollar.

Don't be tempted at the register Don't give in to magazines, lollies, chocolates etc.

Buy fruit & vegetables from markets ... buy in season and locally produced goods and you'll be surprised how much you can save.

Make your own cleaning products.... Example, to clean bathroom tiles, pour white vinegar onto a sponge, sprinkle with baking soda & wipe the tiles over. You may need a toothbrush to scrub the grout between the tiles. Rinse to remove baking soda residue.
